Let's Talk About Rich Men

Understanding Who You're Dealing With

Myth 3: You need to be rich yourself to attract a rich man. You do not need to match his net worth. But you do need to match his **energy**. That means being put together, being knowledgeable, being interesting, and not being desperate. We will cover all of this.

Types of Rich Men

Not all wealthy men are the same. Understanding the different types will help you know who you are dealing with and how to approach them.

The Self-Made Entrepreneur: He built his wealth from scratch. He is usually driven, time-conscious, and does not tolerate laziness. He respects ambition. He wants a woman who has her own thing going on, even if it is small. He is attracted to hunger, intelligence, and loyalty.

■■ **KEY INSIGHT:** Before you pursue any strategy, first determine what type of wealthy man you want. Your approach should match his personality type, not just his bank account.

What Rich Men Actually Want

I have distilled this into five core things that wealthy men consistently look for in a partner:

1. Peace. This is the number one thing. A man who deals with high-pressure decisions all day does not want to come home to drama, arguments, and chaos. He wants calm. He wants a woman who is emotionally stable and does not create unnecessary problems.

2. Presentation. How you look, how you dress, how you carry yourself in public. He will be seen with you. You are a reflection of his taste. This does not mean you need designer everything — it means you need to look put together and intentional.

3. Discretion. Rich men are extremely private. If you are the type to post everything on social media or gossip about your relationship to your friends, you will lose him fast.

4. Intelligence. Not necessarily a degree — but the ability to hold a meaningful conversation, understand basic current events, have opinions, and think critically. A beautiful woman who cannot contribute to a conversation will bore him within weeks.

5. Loyalty. He needs to know you are with him, not his money. This sounds simple but it is the hardest thing to prove. We will cover how to demonstrate this authentically throughout this book.

Are You Ready?

Before we talk about attracting anyone, let us talk about you. Because here is the uncomfortable truth: if you are not ready, no strategy in the world will help you.

This chapter is your honest self-assessment. No judgment. Just clarity.

The Honest Assessment

Answer these questions truthfully. Nobody is watching.

Your Appearance: When you walk into a room, do people notice you for the right reasons? Not because you are loud or dressed provocatively — but because you look polished, put together, and intentional? If the answer is no, that is okay. We will fix it. But we need to start from truth.

Your Conversation: Can you sit across from a stranger at dinner and hold an engaging thirty-minute conversation? Can you talk about more than just gossip, celebrities, and relationship drama? If not, we need to expand your range.

Your Emotional State: Are you emotionally stable? Or do you swing between highs and lows, react impulsively to things, and let your emotions control your decisions? Rich men can spot emotional instability from a mile away, and they will avoid it.

Your Environment: Look at the five people you spend the most time with. Are they ambitious? Do they challenge you? Or do they keep you stuck at the same level? Your circle is either lifting you up or holding you down. There is no neutral.

Your Digital Presence: If a wealthy man found your social media today, what would he think? Would he see someone he would be proud to introduce to his family? Or would he see ratchet posts, half-naked photos, and negativity? Your social media is your silent resume. We will fix this.

The Upgrade Plan

Do not be overwhelmed. You do not need to fix everything at once. Here is the order of priority:

Business Events and Conferences: This is one of the most overlooked goldmines. Industry conferences, business seminars, investment summits, tech events — these rooms are full of ambitious, successful men. Many of these events are free or have affordable tickets. Register, attend, and

network.

Charity Events and Galas: Wealthy people attend charity functions. It is part of their social circle. Find local charity events, fundraisers, and galas. You can often volunteer to attend for free — and volunteering actually gives you a natural reason to talk to people.

High-End Gyms and Fitness Centres: Many successful men are fitness-conscious. Joining a quality gym in an upscale area puts you in proximity to the right people. Even if the membership costs more, consider it an investment.

Art Exhibitions and Cultural Events: Gallery openings, art exhibitions, book launches, wine tastings. These attract sophisticated, cultured men. They are usually free to attend and the atmosphere makes conversation easy and natural.

Religious Institutions: In Nigeria especially, many wealthy men are active in their churches or mosques. Being genuinely involved in your religious community can naturally connect you with successful men.

The Proximity Principle

You do not need to be at every expensive event. What you need is **proximity**. This means placing yourself in environments where wealthy men naturally exist.

The Art of Conversation

How to Talk So He Wants to Keep Listening

Most women lose wealthy men in the first conversation. Not because they said something offensive, but because they were **boring**. Or nervous. Or tried too hard.

Let me teach you how to talk to a rich man in a way that makes him want to talk to you again.

The First Conversation

Attraction is not just physical. It is deeply psychological. Understanding these principles will give you an edge that most women do not have.

Scarcity Creates Value

Before you invest time and energy into attracting a wealthy man, invest in yourself. Every naira you spend on your education, your appearance, your health, your skills — that is an investment with guaranteed returns.

A woman who has invested in herself carries a different energy. She walks differently. She talks differently. She does not need to chase because her value is self-evident.

Patience Is a Strategy

This process takes time. You will not read this book today and marry a millionaire next week. But if you implement what you have learned consistently, you will begin to see shifts — in the quality of men who approach you, in the circles you have access to, and in how you feel about yourself.

Trust the process. The woman you are becoming is worth the wait.
